The Guest Video Protection plugin enables the display of copy protected media.

Guest Video provides copy protected hosting for web pages that can include images, PDF and video.

How It Works

Guest Video uses the ArtistScope Site Protection System (ASPS) which is the most advanced and most secure copy protection solution available today. ASPS is safe from all copy methods on all OS and devices including Windows, Mac, iOS and Android phones. Normally ASPS requires a dedicated server or VPS but Guest Video changes that.

Platform Support

The only web browser suitable for copy protection is the ArtisBrowser, and it is available for Windows, Mac, Android and iOS (iPhone and iPad). While ASPS content is displayed in the ArtisBrowser, it is most securely protected from all exploits and methods for copy and save.

Getting Started

To use the Guest Video service, simply download and install the **Guest Video Protection** plugin. Once installed, you can then register for a free 14-day free trial account at <https://guest.video/join.asp>

Guest Video Protection Settings

The Guest Video Protection settings are managed from your Control Panel at guest.video.

Embedding Copy Protected Pages

If you have the Classic Editor plugin installed you can click on the [Guest Video] button in its toolbar to insert the iFame at the current cursor position. Use the popup window to input the full link to your Guest Video page.

Or you can copy'n'paste the following shortcode (using view source):

Main Page Layout

Guest Video will detect that the requested page is indeed inside an iFrame and subsequently remove the top menu and any side columns to display the main body as large as possible in your assigned iFrame area. The Classic Editor, as with most inline editors, will provide options for displaying the page using a single column template (no side menus). Whether you display the main page with side columns is up to you. Otherwise the iFrame will fit to 100% of the width that your page design allows for the main column.

Embedded Page Layout

Regardless of the layout used on the Guest Video page, when it is displayed in an iFrame the Guest Video top menu, side menu and footer will be removed automatically so that it displays as large as possible in the available space.

Embedded iFrame Size

When inputting the page to display in the iFrame you can also select the iFrame window height. Width will automatically adjust to 100% of the available space, but you have a couple of options for height.

Leaving the height input blank will automatically adjust the iFrame height to fit the content of the nominated page. Or you can limit that height by setting a height in pixels.
